¹The festival is organised in the frame of Darwin Plus Project: DPLUS141: Habitat Restoration & Wise Use for Akrotiri & Cape Pyla. The 3-year Project (2021-2024), which is funded by Darwin Plus in UK, aims to restore important wildlife habitats within the Cyprus SBAs, focusing on Akrotiri wetlands and native scrub on Cape Pyla, to promote wise use of the area and at the same time to develop eco-tourism opportunities to support the local economy. The project partners are BirdLife Cyprus (leading role), Terra Cypria, the Cyprus Sovereign Base Areas Administration - Environment Department (SBAA ED) and the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds.



17:00 - 19:00 Hiking at Apollo Hylates Trail Opposite archaeological site of Apollo Hylates Temple Age 8+ Please Register here


Guided hiking along the trail of Apollo Hylates. The trail goes through scrubland with sparse pines, passes through the ancient Kourion stadium and ends at an elevated point which offers a panoramic view of Episkopi beach and of the ancient settlement. Join us to learn more about the cultural importance of this area and enjoy the beautiful landscape!
